


NRI Grazing Land Survey Instrument

- Often referred to as "web-based CASI"
- Primarily used for data editing
- Requires user name and password
 - To acquire these, send name, email address and phone number to the NRI Grazing Land Help Desk (nri-graze-help@iastate.edu)






Enter your username and password in the communications pop-up screen and select Login



Download Segments


Once you are logged in, you may download segments to your computer.

- 1. Select the survey year
- Select the sample type
- 3. Select the state
- 4. Select the county
- Select Get to download the segment





Segment Checked Out to Computer




Once the segment is checked out, click the x in the upper right-hand corner of the Communications screen

- 2. Select the segment to open it



Opening a Point


Select a point to begin edits


Save edits to the point by selecting Save Point

If the status of the segment is In Progress (IP), check this box to return it to the server as incomplete






Return the Segment to the Server

- 3. Select Return






Close the Communication Screen
